### **NOVA Annual Education Report (AER)**

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for NOVA. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

- 1. The process for assigning students to schools is based on district-approved boundary alignments, ensuring students attend the appropriate school within their designated neighborhood attendance area. However, students residing within the district who wish to attend a different school than their assigned one may request a transfer, provided there is available space at the requested grade level.
- 2. OPHS continues to use the school improvement process to re-evaluate current goals, establish new goals, and collaboratively work together to improve the schools' performance. The School Improvement Plan is available for your review.

- 3. NOVA is the Districts specialized secondary school to meet the needs of a wide variety of student needs and interests. NOVA is an alternative high school addressing the needs of learners in a smaller setting with specialized curriculum pathways.
- 4. The OPSD curriculum does not vary from the state of Michigan standards. A copy of the standards can be found here: Oak Park Curriculum
- 5. NOVA administered the IReady benchmark assessments to all students in Mathematics and Reading in grades 6-12. The assessments are given three times each year. Student data is analyzed to identify strengths and areas of need for students, classes, grade levels and schools. Teachers utilize data to guide instruction and meet the needs of individual students as well as set goals for growth and building school improvement.


